Daily Evening Reflections

A short video providing a bible reading, prayer and reflection from a range of ecumenical partners, lay and clergy from across Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire.

A celebration of prayer and worship featuring contributions from lay and clergy from across the Christian traditions and including a talk from His Eminence Archbishop Angaelos of the Coptic Orthodox Church.
